**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, SECTION 2-21,
OF THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY CODE, ENTITLED
INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE INDUSTRIAL
DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF GLOUCESTER COUNTY TO THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
AUTHORITY OF GLOUCESTER COUNTY.**

WHEREAS, the Gloucester County Board of Supervisors has been asked by the Industrial Development Authority to consider changing the name of the Industrial Development Authority of Gloucester County to the Economic Development Authority of Gloucester County; and

WHEREAS, after consideration the Board believes that it would be appropriate to grant the request and change the name to the Economic Development Authority of Gloucester County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THIS 7TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2004, THAT:

Chapter 2, Section 2-21, of the County Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-21. Economic development authority.

There is hereby created a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, with such public and corporate powers as are set forth in the Industrial Development and Revenue Bond Act, constituting chapter 49 of title 15.2 of the Code of Virginia. The name of the political subdivision, originally created as the Industrial Development Authority of Gloucester County, Virginia, shall be the Economic Development Authority of Gloucester County, Virginia, effective October 1, 2004.
